The Bjugn/Ørland Skøyteklubb and Norwegian Speed Skating Association take the pleasure to invite you to take part in the following International speed-skating competition:

### **28<sup>th</sup> Masters' International Allround Games** **Bjugn (Norway), March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

This competition will be held according to the under-mentioned conditions, the Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC), the Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU). This competition takes place on the 400m indoor standard speed-skating track of "FosenHallen" in Bjugn (Norway), on artificial ice. This competition is an event of the IMSSC International Masters', the International ISU's and the Norwegian Ice Sports Federation's 2018/2019 Calendars.

**1. Number of Competitors – No Quota**

This is a three-days Allround competition. It is open to Master Ladies and Men starting from 30 age group upward (as necessary).

**The competition is limited to 250 competitors.** No quota for the different Nations are established. Registrations will begin on October 1<sup>st</sup> and the chronological order of registration will be taken into account. If the competitors registered are more than 250, a waiting list is foreseen in the registration system. In case a skater withdraws his/her registration, he/she may be substituted by a skater from the same Nation, and substitution may be made until the Team Leader Meeting at the latest.

**2. Age Groups**

This competition takes place based on the following five-year age groups (**AG** = five-year age groups Masters, Ladies and Men, according to their birth date, as indicated hereunder):

**3. Eligibility**

To be eligible, a skater must be a member of a National Speed Skating Federation recognized by the ISU, and must have a license of his/her Federation.

**4. Distances**

Ladies (age group 30 and higher): 500m, 1,500m, 1,000m, 3,000m;

Men (age group 30-60): 500m, 3,000m, 1,500m, 5,000m;

Men (age group 65 and higher): 500m, 1,500m, 1,000m, 3,000m.

Quartet start may be used for all distances except 500m.

The **D Pattern** of Sub-Rule 3.1.1, *Masters' International Allround Games*, of *IMSSC Constitution & Regulations* will be followed, consisting in the following structure:

Days	Men, 30-60 AG	Ladies / Men, 65+ AG
First Day	500m	500m 1,500m
Second Day	3,000m 1,500m	1,000m
Third Day	5,000m	3,000m

**Every skater that has finalized three distances according to IMSSC and ISU rules is allowed to skate the fourth and longest distance.**





## **5. Limit times**

According to Rule 3.1.6, every participant has to inform his national IMSSC Member about his/her most recent time in the 1.500m distance. It is the responsibility of the national IMSSC Member to accept times. If the applicable time does not meet the maximum time as laid down in the table below (MaximumTime Table), the participant cannot take part in the Allround Games, unless the national IMSSC Member decides otherwise in a written consent.

The 400m ice track is open for training every day between 09:00 and 21:00 except competition days, and the information is also published at the Organizers' web-site: [www.bosk.no](http://www.bosk.no) A daily admittance fee must be paid NOK 70,00, unless on Thursday March 21<sup>st</sup> (official training) and on all competition days.

### **7. Drawing & Classification**

On the first two distances of the Allround Games, the skaters shall be seeded in three groups before drawing, according to their best times of the season, their best times of last season, or their estimated times. The seeding occurs per Age Group or per joined Age Groups.

Drawing at the Masters' International Allround Games will be done according to ISU Rule 244 for Drawing at International Competitions. For drawing, the ISU Rule 244, Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 apply, as well as ISU Rule 240, Paragraph 4.

Neighbored five-year age groups with a small number of participants may be put together for drawing and racing. But the allotting of track on the third distance is decided by the ranking after two distances for each 5 year age group, and not by the ranking in the joined, neighbored groups. The final distance drawing and classification must be done in her/his own age group independent of the number of participants in that age group. In the combined groups the age group of each skater will appear behind his/her name in the protocol. The winner of the four-distance competition in his/her age group is the skater who has completed all distances successfully and has obtained the lowest total of points in his/her five year age group.

### **8. Recommendation to Competitors**

During races, skaters are recommended to overtake other skaters racing in the same lane **only on the outside** (overtaking often takes place in races with quartet starts).

### **9. Prizes and Results of the Four-Distance Combination**

For the four-distance combination, the first three competitors of a five-year age group will be awarded a prize. All participants who finish all four distances of the competition successfully, without being disqualified, obtain a certificate, a medal and a protocol with the results.

The complete results with lap times, accumulated lap times and end times can be found at the Organizing Committee's web-site.

Every participant will receive a souvenir at the registration (included in the entry fee).





## **10. Doping control**

Anti-doping tests may be carried out in accordance with ISU Rule 139.

## **11. Liability**

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, ISU, IMSSC and the Organizing Committee assume **no responsibility for, or liability with respect to, bodily or personal injury, or property damages**, incurred in connection with this competition. Each skater or accompanying person is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage there to.

## **12. Entries**

Generally, entries are accepted in chronological order. However, Finland (FIN) and The Netherlands (NED) will make their entries after a qualification process.

In case a skater entered is prevented from participating in the competition because of an illness, injury or other unforeseen cause, he/she may be substituted by another skater of the same Nation from the Waiting List. Substitution must be carried out until the Team Leader Meeting at the latest.

## **13. Confirmation of Participation**

A competitor is obliged to confirm his participation in person at the latest one hour before the first Team Leader Meeting of the competition. #### **14. Entry Fee**

The entry fee is 125 € **per person**. It includes the Welcome Drink and the Closing Banquet.  
At the Closing Banquet drinks are **not** included.
