



MCLN (the Dutch Masters Speed Skating Association) invites you with pleasure to participate in the following international speed skating competition:

Dutch Masters Cup 2025-2026

- Enschede, the Netherlands, Sunday, 23rd November 2025
- Heerenveen, the Netherlands, Saturday, 13rd December 2025
- Leeuwarden, the Netherlands, Saturday, 20th January 2025

This competition will be held according to the Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) and the Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) on the following covered 400m standard speed skating tracks on artificial ice:

- **Ijsbaan Twente**, Colosseum 90, 7521 PT Enschede, The Netherlands
- **Thialf**, Pim Mulierlaan 1, 8443 DA Heerenveen, The Netherlands
- **11stedenhal**, Fryslânplein 1, 8914 BZ Leeuwarden, The Netherlands

These races are events of the IMSSC International Masters', the International ISU's and the Dutch Ice Sports Federation's 2025/2026 Calendars.

1 Competitions

Women and men (from age group 30): Single Distance Races.

Possible Distances 500 m combined with one of the following distances.

Possible combinations: 500 m & 1.000 m or,
500 m & 1.500 m or,
500 m & 3.000 m or,
500 m & 5.000 m.

Quartet start will be used for all distances. You can take part in one of more races of this competition of the Dutch Masters Cup.

2 Age Groups

This competition will be organized in the following five-year age groups (**AG** = five-year age groups Masters, Women and Men, according to their birth date, as indicated hereunder):

3 Eligibility

To be eligible, a skater must be a member of a National (Speed) Skating Federation recognized by the ISU, and must have a license of his/her federation.

4 Limitation of participants

The competitions are restricted to 80 skaters in Enschede, 88 skaters in Leeuwarden and 124 skaters in Heerenveen. You will be informed as soon as possible after your entry if you can take part in the competition.

5 Drawing and classification

Digitally by the Referee one day before each competition and published on the website www.schaatscircuit.nl. The drawing will be done in groups of 4 skaters, according to their best times of the current season, their best times of last season or their personal best times (and in that order). The seeding will be done per joined Age Groups (women and men together), the classification will be separately women group and a men group. See also 'Prices and results'.

6 Prices and results

There will be prices and a price giving ceremony after the 3rd competition (the final competition in Heerenveen). There will be prices for the top 3 Women and the top 3 Men.

Complete protocols (containing also starting times, lap times and accumulated lap times) of each competition will be published on the website www.schaatscircuit.nl.

You will get points on the distance where you skate the most close to the World record of last year. During the final competition you will get one and a half number of points. By skating a World record you will get a bonus of 75 points.

By this way there will be a battle between sprinters and long distance skaters. And a battle between all Age Groups.

Example of point counting

A Women in the Age Group 30 (L30) skates 42,50 on the 500 m. The World record last season was 39,51. That means a percentage of 92,49%. A women L40 skates 42,99 on the 500 m and the World record L40 is 41,26, which means a percentage of 95,98%. Another Women in the Age Group L65 has a time of 50,01 (World record is 49,44). The winner of this competition is the women L55 with a time of 2.20,27 on the 1.500m. The World record is 2.19,27 which means a percentage of 99,29%

However, this e-mail message does not confirm your participation. After payment has been made and received at the Organizing Committee. A competitor is obliged to confirm his participation in person at the latest a half hour before the start of each competition.

12 Entry fee for competitors

Entrance fee will be: **32,50 euro** for 500 m & 1.000 m

49,50 euro for 500 m & 3.000 m
57,00 euro for 500 m & 5.000 m
