17th Masters' International SPRINT GAMES 2026 24th and 25th of January 2026 Olympiaworld Innsbruck / Austria

The competition is to be held in accordance with the following conditions of contest, the Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) at the 400 m Outdoor-Standard Speed Skating Track with radii of 25 and 29 m the Olympic rink in Innsbruck on artificial ice. This competition is a regular event of the International Masters' Competition Calendar of the IMSSC.

1. IMSSC.Distances & Eligibility

The competition will take place on Saturday, 24 January and Sunday, 25 January, 2026. It is a four-distance sprint competition over a schedule of two days.

Day 1 Saturday, 24 January, 2026 Women and Men: 500m #1 and 1,000m #1 Day 2 Sunday, 25 January, 2026 Women and Men: 500m #2 and 1,000m #2

To be eligible, skaters must be a member of a National Speed Skating Federation recognized by the ISU and must have a license.

2. Age Groups

The competition takes place based on the following five-year age groups:

d. Team Leaders Meeting, Drawing And Classification

The team leaders meeting will be held on Friday, 23 January 2026, at 15:30, in the Olympiaworld Meeting Room (1st floor Foyer B Nord).

At this meeting, entries will be confirmed and information regarding the event will be distributed. The draw will take place immediately following this meeting. There will not be a second team leaders meeting. Drawings at the Masters Sprint Games must be done according to ISU Rule 240 paragraph 4, with four exceptions:

• On all the distances all 5-year age will be drawn/paired together and will compete together (Women and Men separately).

• Pairing for the third and fourth distances will be done based respectively on the classification after 2 and 3 distances. In both cases the lane (inner and outer) will be changed for every skater with reference

respectively to the first distance (for the third) and to the second distance (for the fourth). However, every classification and the final ranking after 4 distances, must be done in separate 5-year age groups.

- All competitors will be admitted to the last distance.
 An exception to this is when a competitor has received a Yellow Card from the Referee, the competitor is then excluded from the rest of the competition (ISU Rule 275 Disqualification).
- If at more than 100 participants are competing, they shall be divided into two or more blocks. The first block completes its two distances before the next block, and so on. This will reduce waiting time between the two distances.



A skater who completes all distances successfully and obtains the lowest total of points in his/her five-year age group wins the four-distance competition in that group.

Quartet starts may be used for the 500m and 1,000m distance.

4. <u>Limitation of Participants</u>

5. Limit Times

If a skater wishes to participate in Masters Sprint Games, they must meet the following requirements in order to be allowed entry into the competition:

- a) have a documented time (500m for MSG) on <u>www.speedskatingresults.com</u>, <u>www.speedskatingnews.info</u> or similar, and;
- b) have a documented time that meets the Minimum Time Standard (MTS) set forth in button, and;
- c) have skated that MTS time during the previous two seasons.

If a skater fails to meet requirements a) or b) above they should contact their IMSSC Country Representative. The organizer of the Masters Sprint Games and the Board of the IMSSC will decide whether the request will be honored. Contact info@imssc.org for assistance identifying your country representative.

For the four-distance combination, the first three competitors of each five-year age group will be awarded a prize. Any competitor who successfully finishes the competition without disqualification obtains a certificate containing the final results, which can be downloaded from our website.

8. Entries

Entries must be made by filling in the Electronic Entry Form available on this <u>LINK</u>. Based on your selection, we will send an invoice for payment to your e-mail address!

Dutch participants must first register via their regular channels on the website <u>www.schaatscircuit.nl</u> and <u>inschrijven.schaatsen.nl</u> in connection with their nomination/qualification process.

Also **Norway** has its own registration and withdrawal procedure! Skaters must register by sending their names to the following email: nmssc2016@gmail.com The registration deadline for Norway is November 15, 2025.

You can view and edit your entry at any time until the entry deadline.

A competitor is obliged to confirm his participation in person at the latest three hour before the Team Leader Meeting of the competition. If the competitor is not able to confirm in person, he must inform the competition organization via email, phone, SMS or WhatsApp specifying first and last name at the latest 24 hours before the drawing of the competition.

Deadline for Entries: Friday, 19 December, 2025 at 24:00 MESZ (Berlin)

9. Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is fixed at € 165 (Euro) per competitor. This includes a ticket to the admittance to all Official Practice Sessions, Welcome Drink, a ticket to the Closing Banquet, as well the transfer on Monday 25 January from Innsbruck (Austria) to Inzell (Germany). The entrance fee must be paid prior to the registration deadline on 19 December, 2025 at 24:00 MESZ

It has to be paid via bank transfer to the account mentioned below. Unofficial training periods for Masters' (look under item 3.a in Schedule) must be paid also.






